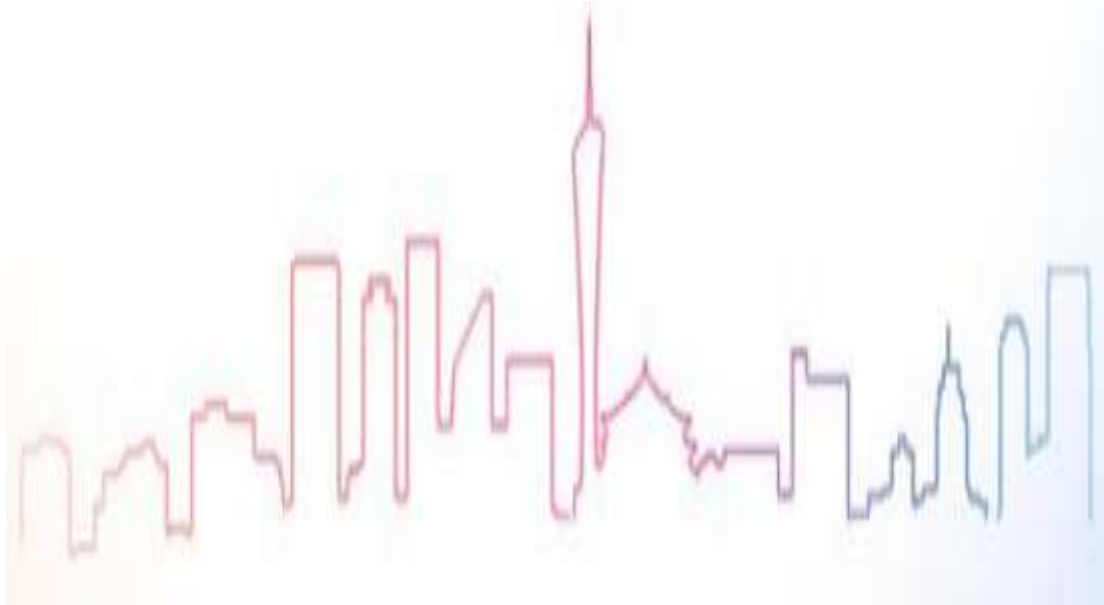

After a two-round assessment by the Technical Committee and the Jury, the five laureates of the 1st Guangzhou Award were Kocaeli (Turkey), Lilongwe (Malawi), Seoul (Korea), Vancouver (Canada), and Vienna (Austria).
